'It's Good to be Green'



A key message of how we share our behaviour policy with pupils is 'It's Good to Be Green'.

In rewarding pupils' good behaviour we provide a half-termly reward day for all pupils whose behaviour has been consistently good.

Every day, children start on green but with 0 points. Pupils who follow the school rules stay on green and earn 2 points. Children who choose not to follow the school rules are initially given a verbal warning but will still earn 2 points if they immediately improve their behaviour.

If pupils continue to misbehave, they will be given a final warning (we issue a yellow card). Providing they then improve their behaviour, they will earn 1 point for that day.

If pupils still misbehave they will be given a sanction (we issue a red card), such as missing part of break time or moving to another part of the classroom to work. When there is really serious misbehaviour, pupils will be issued with an immediate red card.

Over a half-term, if a pupil receives two red cards, they will be sent to the Deputy Headteacher (Ms Gunn or Mrs Taylor), who will arrange a meeting with parents and issue a sanction. If a pupil receives three red cards, they will be sent to Miss Cornforth who will set up a report card, arrange a meeting with parents and also issue a sanction, such as missing the termly reward day.

To promote good behaviour, children can earn extra points if they demonstrate exemplary behaviour (this can help those who make an extra effort after days where they have earned less than 2 points).

Children who earn 10 or more points a week will be given a 'Good to be Green' sticker so parents know straight away that their child has behaved well that week.

Each term, daily points are added together and children who 'stay on green' almost all of the time will be able to join in the half-term reward day.

This half-term, pupils need to have earned 60 points.

Hopefully the clear rewards and behaviour monitoring will help us all celebrate the great behaviour that staff and visitors to the school see on a daily basis.
