Breakfast Club

Just a reminder of Breakfast Club procedures.

- Children can arrive from 8am and will be taken by a member of staff to the yard at 8:45am (weather permitting)
- Breakfast Club is £1.20 per day or £5 for the full week. This is not refundable or carried forward to the following week in the case of absence.
- Breakfast club fees are payable even if your child does not require a breakfast (childcare costs)
- Any children not attending Breakfast club should not come into the main entrance before 8:45am.

Please remember that one weeks' notice should be given to change from dinners to packed lunch and vice versa.

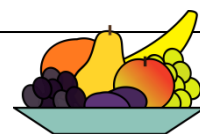
