Attendance

I would like to remind you about the importance of good attendance and punctuality. Days off school soon add up and missing lessons makes it hard to catch up, resulting in children having to work harder when they come back, or even missing vital information that may affect their progress.

Good attendance is now 96%, which is approximately 10 days absence in a year. If your child's attendance is below 90% they are classed as being persistently absent from school and this may trigger involvement from outside agencies.

Holidays in term time can have a huge impact on your child's end of year attendance. We need to work together to ensure good school attendance. If you need any support with school attendance please contact the school.
