Dear Parents,

World Oceans Day June 8th

School are having an ocean themed day on Friday 8th June to celebrate World Ocean's Day. The children from both sites will join together at the Village Site to learn about how we can help to prevent plastic pollution and encourage people to think of better solutions for a healthy ocean.

Children from the Hill Site will be bussed down and back and will have their lunch at the Village Site. Those children who have packed lunches should bring their packed lunch to school as normal and those who stay for school dinners will receive their normal menu choice. Children will be back at the Hill Site well before the end of the school day and should be picked up at the normal time.

The day will start with a whole school assembly to explain why we need to work together to save our oceans, led by Daniel Moore, a Polar Ambassador from Durham University. The children will then work on activities linked to World Oceans - such as writing poetry, producing artwork and watching videos about our oceans.

During the day children will be challenged to create a class sculpture using only recycled plastic, which can be exhibited to highlight the impact of plastic waste in our oceans. These works of art must be completed by the end of June, so that they can be displayed in school. Please could you send in any clean plastic items that children could use for their models from tomorrow onwards.

Sports Day/Transition

There will be a whole school Sports Day on Tuesday 10th July at the Village Site starting at 1pm, weather permitting. We hope that you are able to join us. Children from the Hill Site will be bussed down and back. They will spend the morning in class with their new teachers before participating in a range of sporting activities in the afternoon.
