School Uniform

The time of year is here again when adverts for school uniform start appearing. I wish to remind parents of the correct uniform as on occasion children come into school in non-uniform items. When purchasing uniform, please bear in mind the colours stated in the uniform policy:

- Trousers/ Skirts/ Pinafores/ Shorts – **GREY OR BLACK**
- Jumper / Cardigan – **RED**
- Summer dresses – **RED & WHITE CHECK**
- Socks/ Tights – **RED / GREY** (black may be worn under trousers)
- Polo Shirts / Shirts / Blouses – **WHITE**
- School shoes – **BLACK – NO HIGH HEELS OR TRAINERS**

PE Kit – plain red t-shirt and plain black shorts (this can be bought through school as a complete kit in a PE bag), plimsolls or spare trainers. PE Kits should be available in school **at all times** - we suggest that P.E. kit is brought into school in a drawstring bag and left here most of the time. Most children take it home for washing at the end of each half-term.
