# **Coronavirus Advice**

We have been asked by Durham County Council to share the following information with you:

Reporting symptoms after the school closes for Christmas Holidays

Sherburn Primary School will close on December 18th. If your child develops symptoms of coronavirus you must book a test.

If your child develops symptoms that result in a positive test, up to and including December 20th you must inform the school at via the school website.

Please include the name of your child, their class and the date that their symptoms started, as well as your own contact details.

#### From Monday 21st December

If your child develops coronavirus symptoms from Monday 21st December onwards, they must be tested and, if positive, follow the advice of Test and Trace. You do not need to inform the school of any symptoms which occur after this date.
