MILK IS GREAT!

Milk provides many important vitamins, minerals and calcium, all of which are vital for growing children.

Milk is a great source of energy and protein and helps keep children hydrated, which also helps to maintain concentration in school.

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Visit our secure website at **www.schoolmilkuk.co.uk** to register your child. You will need a valid email address to do so, and please have your child's school and class details to hand.

Please note, you only need to register if:

- 1. Your child will turn 5 in the coming term, or
- 2. Your child is already 5 or older.

(If your child is entitled to free school meals, you may be entitled to free school milk. Please check with your school office before registering).



You can choose to pay for the coming term or for the entire school year. If you register during the term or school year, our system will only charge you for the remaining school days.



After selecting the period you wish to pay for, you will be asked to agree to our terms and conditions and enter the details of your method of payment. You can pay by PayPal or credit or debit card.



That's it! Your child's milk will be delivered to school in time for them to drink during mid-morning break. Our milk is delivered in refrigerated vehicles to ensure it arrives at your child's school at the peak of freshness.

We provide dairy products subsidised by the European Union under the European School Milk Scheme.

We have an order deadline of Wednesday evening for milk required for the following week. Orders placed on Thursday onwards will receive milk the subsequent week and will be charged accordingly.

We take data protection very seriously and our secure website uses the latest encryption standards. We never share your data with any third parties.
