## Packed Lunches

## Co-op Recycling Scheme

We have teamed up with the Co-op to support them with their soft plastics recycling scheme. It means we can all do our bit for the environment. It's really easy

- **Clean it** – First, rinse your packaging out.
- **Scrunch it** – Now, scrunch it up tight - if it pings back, it's a useful indicator it's soft plastic.
- **Co-op it** – Bring it into school this week (there's a collection bin in the dining hall) and during the Easter Assembly on Friday it will be given to a team member from the Co-op.

There is a big list of soft plastics which can be recycled – this includes:

- Thin plastic lids of all types
- Pouches – microwave rice, pre-cooked mussels, pet food, etc
- Plastic sauce sachets
- Ordinary carrier bags
- Crisps, nuts, snacks bags
- Bags from: Cereal and porridge
- Frozen foods and ice cubes
- Kitchen towel, toilet roll, nappy bag, cotton wool wrappers
- Fruit & veg nets, bags and wrappers
- Bags
- Bread bags
- Dried goods – dried fruit, pasta, rice, sugar, pulses, etc
- Wrappers & Film
